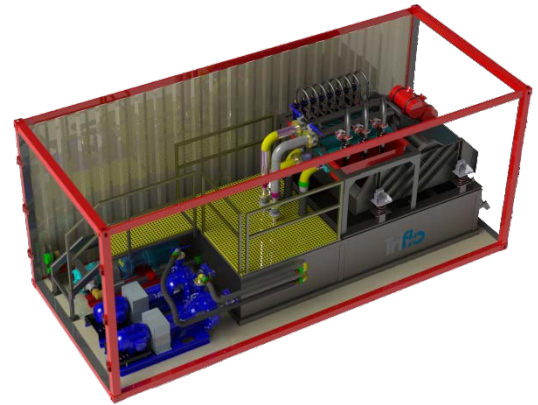

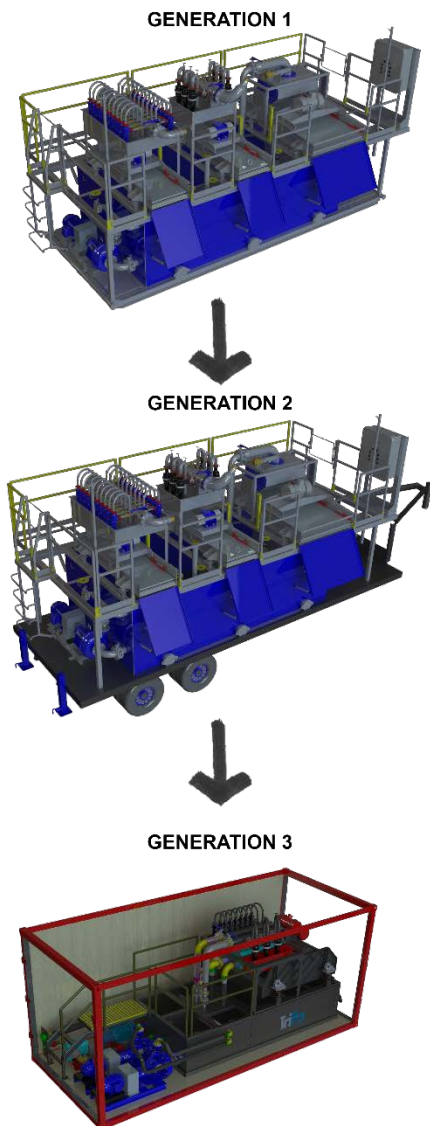

Evolution of Product

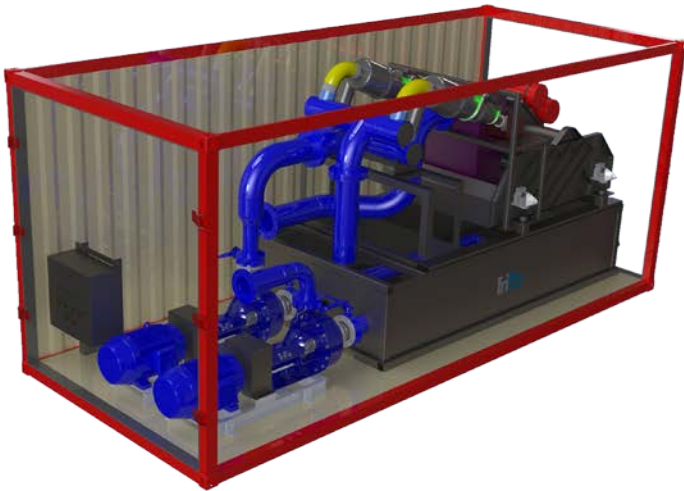

In order to satisfy the growing needs of the industry Triflo's equipment packages have evolved over time, from a traditional tank system on a skid, to trailered integrated tanks, and now to tank systems enclosed within shipping containers. This evolution has been in response to the industries' need for transportable products that are quick and easy to set up and begin operation. **Figure 2** shows this evolution of our three phase separation technology.

Why Choose a Containerized System?

A containerized system has many benefits for the customer. Solids control equipment systems are a substantial investment for any company and having them enclosed inside of a container helps to protect this investment by keeping them safe from the elements, in addition to being able to lock them up and secure them on the jobsite in the evenings. Transportation cost is also something to consider when purchasing solids control equipment as it is an associated cost that extends through the life of the equipment as you move from job to job. This is one of the biggest reasons to consider a container system as shipping a container, especially overseas, can be substantially cheaper than shipping an irregularly sized and shaped load.

Packages Currently Offered

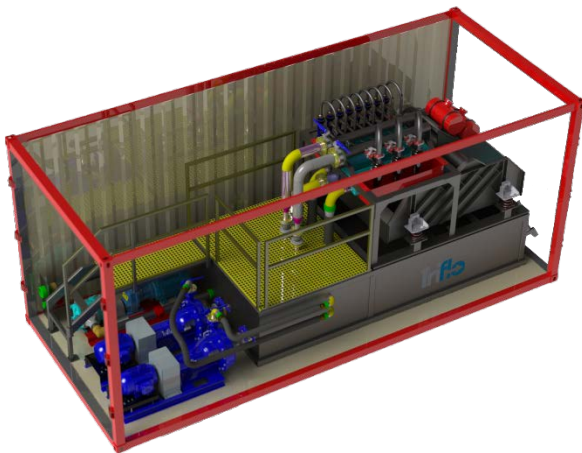

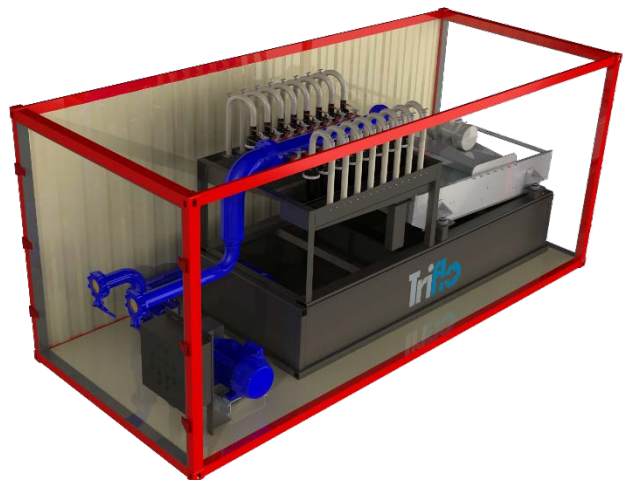
Two Phase, 1000 GPM De-Sanding Unit



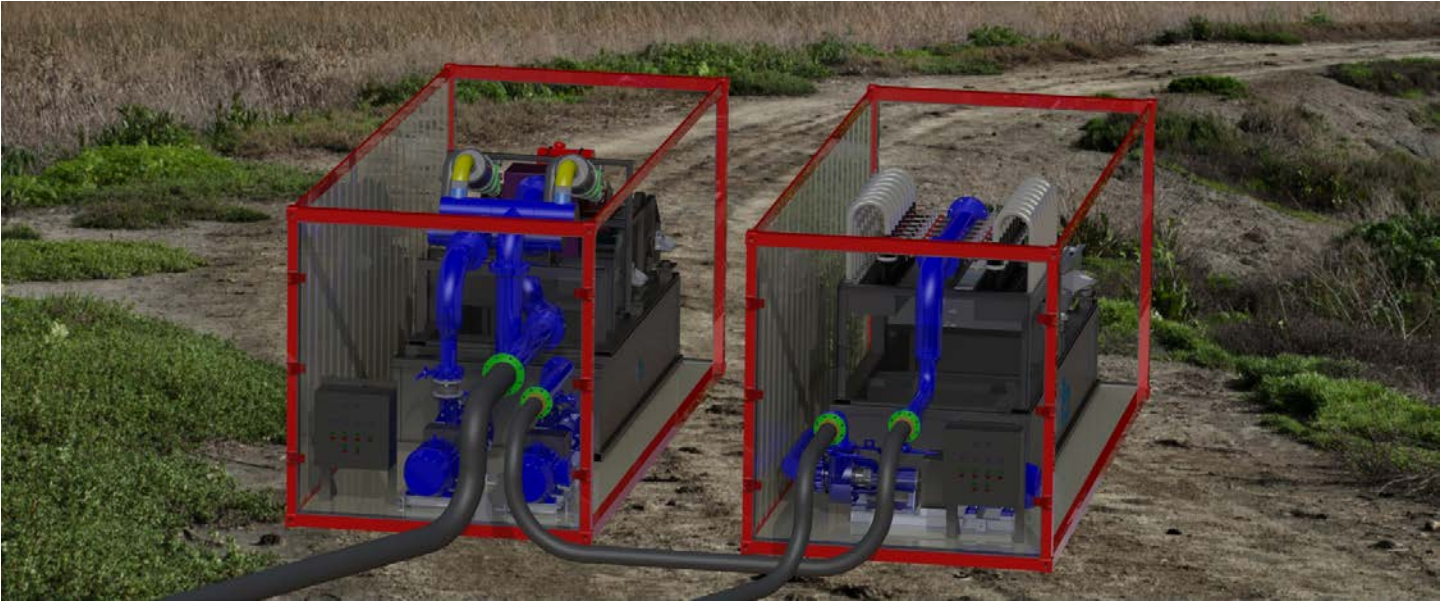
Removable Equipment Skid for De-Sanding Unit for Non Routine Maintenance
